



The LivingAll second six monthly meeting was celebrated in Ljubljana

The LivingAll second six monthly meeting was celebrated in Ljubljana on the 13th and 14th of March 2008. It has been the 3rd meeting of the members of the LivingAll consortium.

The LivingAll partners reviewed the workpackages just finished **Wp3: Evaluation of the use of the free movement rights management by the disabled**. As a result of this workpackage the following deliverables have been completed: **D3.1: Questionnaire for data collection**, which has been used with 100 disabled people in 7 European countries; **D3.2: Sample design and action plan** and **D3.3: Information gathering in 7 countries**. The LivingAll partners also established the criteria to follow to complete the tasks in process of **Wp4: Detection of main barriers regarding the disabled free movement in Europe: Task 4.1 Statistical study of free movement of disabled people** and **Task 4.2 detection and classification of main barriers that inhibit free movement** which will be published by the end of April or early May.

After considering the talks already done, the partners were working on the definition and organisation of the next six months work: **Wp5 Good practices selection to cover the existing barriers**. The objectives of this workpackage is to select and validate the existing good practices that support free movement of disabled people, related to the barriers that these permit them to cover; discuss and propose solutions or guidelines for the detected and non solved barriers; and produce a guide containing these good practices. Polibienestar, project coordinator, leads this workpackage.

Some of the most important points discussed there were the management issues and program content of the **LivingAll European Conference**, which will finally be celebrated in January 2009 in Valencia. In the LivingAll Conference, all partners will promote the results of the LivingAll research with the support of the expert members of the AC who have been advising the consortium in the LivingAll research. The LivingAll partners will also invite policy makers, representatives of the public administrations, representatives of the European Commission, representatives from the associations of disabled people...
