



### The LivingAll third six monthly meeting was celebrated in Vienna

The LivingAll third six monthly meeting was celebrated in Vienna on 4<sup>th</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> September 2008. In the meeting, the LivingAll partners reviewed the results of **Wp4: Detection of main barriers regarding free movement of disabled people in Europe**: *D4.1 Report presenting the real situation of free movement and equal opportunities rights for people with disability in Europe (LivingAll statistics report)* and *D4.2 Main barriers to free movement of people with disability. Detection and classification of main barriers that inhibit free movement in seven European countries*. The partners also established the criteria to follow in **Wp5: Good practices selection to cover the existing barriers**. The objective of Wp5 is to select and validate the existing good practices that support free movement for disabled people.

Together with the meeting and as part of Wp5, the partners developed the task 5.2 of the project "LivingAll partners' workshop". In it, a selection of the more relevant barriers reported by disabled people was made and the researchers involved in the project proposed guidelines to overcome them. The results of the workshop will provide basic information to start working in the elaboration of the LivingAll guide of good practices.

Some aspects regarding the **LivingAll European conference** – Valencia, 15<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> January - were also established in the meeting. Coordinators of other European projects with similar objectives will participate describing their main conclusions: MHADI project, OPTIWORK project and DIS-QOL project; and the experts of the LivingAll Advisory Committee will provide the view of the different stakeholders. The conference will also provide some time for open contributions concerning disability issues. In the following days, some representatives of the DG of Employment of the European Commission, of the High Level Group on Disability and of the national and regional governments will confirm their assistance.
